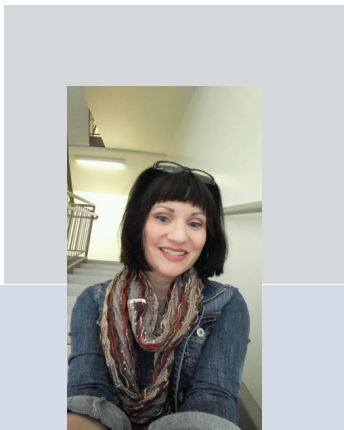
Adobe Connect & Synchronous Online Education
