WHAT: A competitive 3-week writing institute for high school students to:

- Learn writing skills necessary for academic success
- Participate in fun, activity-based workshops
- Enjoy opportunities to explore UA programs and facilities
- Collaborate with students from different schools
- Contribute to a printed anthology of writing

Includes: Closing reception, certificate, and printed anthology of writing

WHEN: July 10 - 28, 2017

WHERE: University of Arizona Main Campus

WHO: Up to 20 high school students (grades 9-12 in fall 2017)

COSTS: \$15 non-refundable application fee (Application does not guarantee acceptance) \$300 tuition (Three tuition awards available)

APPLICATION PROCESS: Apply online at wsip.arizona.edu

Application materials: Letter of support from a school representative or work/volunteer supervisor and a 250 word essay about your interest in the Young Writers Institute.

TUITION AWARD APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

Must be college bound 11th or 12th grader Must be first person in immediate family to attend college Must include GPA

Must include 200 word essay discussing how attending this program will help support your goal of attending college in the future
